

Installation:

Unzip the file "TTL.zip" to hard disk and you will find a file "TTLReport.exe" under the TTL directory.

Start the program:

Execute the file "TTLReport.exe" and then the program will start.

Data Source:

You can get data from three different ways.

1) *“Connect...” option under “File” menu*

If the program is installed on a workstation located on the SAMS LAN, you can connect to the database directly. Select “Connect...” option under “File” menu and then you must enter valid connection information. A list will be prompted if there is more than one result set available.

2) *“Import...” option under “File” menu*

You can import WebSAMS data to the program by select “Import...” option under “File” menu and then you must enter the corresponding file names. Similarly, a list will be prompted if there is more than one result set available.

In order to get the data from WebSAMS, you must select “Get Query...” option under “Help” menu and then save the XML file first. And then connect to WebSAMS and import the file under Data Management module. And then you can execute the imported task and save the generated data in Excel format. That’s the files for the add-on program.

3) *“Open...” option under “File” menu*

If you had used the “Save” or “Save As...” option under the “File” menu, then you can select the “Open...” option under the “File” menu to reload the data with the saved parameter.

Timetable Display:

You can view or export the timetable.

1) Display

Select option under any one of the “Class”, “Room”, “Teacher” or “Subject” menu, and you will see the timetable displayed on the screen.

2) Export

Select the file format from the “Export...” option under “File” menu, and then a popup window shown. You can move the required timetable form left to right and enter the filename. The timetable will be generated after you press the OK button.
