A simple guideline on how to perform WebSAMS build version upgrade has been placed on the site for your reference.

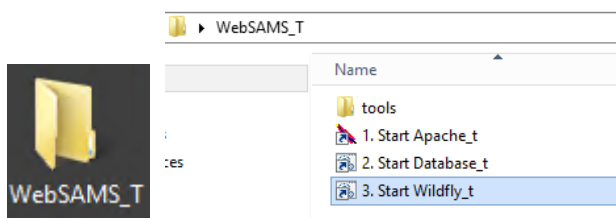

Enhancements

1. System

- Replace WebSAMS essential program component, Zulu Java 7, with Zulu Java 11.
- Further strengthen the system security.
- Support Chrome web browser in using all modules.
- The shortcut of Start WebSAMS is changed from “3. Start Jboss” to “3. Start Wildfly”



2. SEC

- Require all users to reset password after this new build upgrade.

3. SCH

- Add new function to export WebSAMS school calendar information to an iCalendar format file.

4. INA

- Replace “Institute Application” with “申請大專院校(只提供英文版)” in the Chinese menu. The corresponding Chinese sub-menu could not be expanded and the module could only be used under the English version.

Application User Manuals

- SCH - Both Chinese and English versions are updated

Tips on safeguarding the security of WebSAMS

In order to safeguard the system security, it is strongly recommended that schools should conduct the following **important security related tasks and checking** regularly :

- 1) Ensure successful execution of WebSAMS **backup** on a daily basis;
- 2) Perform **scheduled anti-virus scan** for WebSAMS server and HTTP server on a daily basis and ensure that the **anti-virus software is up-to-date**;

- 3) Check **unsuccessful login log** to monitor the usage of both WebSAMS and Windows on a daily basis;
and
 - 4) Monitor and **block abnormal network traffic** (please consult your network vendor if necessary).

Gentle Reminder to WebSAMS Users

With an aim to safeguarding the security of WebSAMS, schools are recommended to follow the guidelines of “Information Security in Schools – Recommended Practice” at the location of:

Every item included in the “IT Security in Schools – Recommended Practice (ITSS) ” is applicable to WebSAMS and essential for the establishment and maintenance of the IT Security Policy defined by every school.

Schools should install the Important Windows Updates (excluding the “Service Pack” and “Major Version Upgrade”) of Microsoft Windows Server 2012 R2 timely. Please refer to the “Doc 31 – WebSAMS Computer Operation Procedures Manual for School” at the following location for details:

In particular to the areas of password management and incident handling procedures, the following are highlighted in order to assist schools reviewing their definition and enforcement:

- a) All WebSAMS users are required to have their own identities or user accounts in order to access the system. Passwords should not be shared or divulged unless necessary. The risk of sharing passwords is that it would increase the probability of security being compromised. If individual user account is used and no password is shared, user activities on the system can thus be traceable and accountable to the corresponding person. Schools should also review their own IT security policy or practice to avoid password sharing of the WebSAMS user accounts.*
- b) Schools should well define their own Security Incident Handling Procedures for IT Systems including WebSAMS and notify the right people accordingly.*

In order to ensure system and data security, schools are also recommended to refer to the “WebSAMS Security Guide and Recommended Practice” (<http://cdr.websams.edb.gov.hk/Files/Security/security.pdf>) and conduct checking of WebSAMS system security settings on a regular basis as well as a need basis by making good use of (a) the Security Check function in WebSAMS; and (b) System Security Setting Checklist for WebSAMS.
